Upholds the honor of the profession in all relations with students, colleagues, coaches, administrators and the general public avoids using the position for personal gain or influence.

Seeks to improve the professional status and effectiveness of the interscholastic program through participation in local, state and national in-service programs.

Is committed to high standards of ethics, sportsmanship, and personal conduct among the members of the coaching staff and the athletes representing their school, assuring that proper respect is exhibited toward officials, opponents and their property.

RECOMMENDED PROCEDURES








In order to avoid confusion and problems with the submittal of required information, the administrator in charge for each district should comply with the following:

- Submit certification forms and addenda on official forms provided by U.I.L. Typewritten forms are preferred; however, neatly handwritten forms may be accepted.
- The Chair of the Executive Committee subject to ratification by the Executive Committee will approve all forms requiring committee action.
- The individuals indicated should sign the forms. This is especially sensitive relative to students who have participated previously in athletics in other districts.
- Observe the chain of command within the limits of each district. Superintendents, High School Principals and Athletic Directors are encouraged to resolve problems whenever possible.
- Official communications with the chair of the Executive Committee are reserved for the Superintendents, High School Principals and Athletic Directors.
- 32-3A individual schools will police their own sub-varsity teams. Violations should be reported to the district chairman for review.
- Sports organizational meetings prior to start of each sport will be held at central site.
- Rescheduling of new game dates will only be allowed for the UIL and extracurricular scheduling conflicts.
- Varsity eligibility forms certified by the superintendent or designated administrator must be submitted prior to the first contest to the chairman of the district executive committee.

Video cameras may be allowed at 32-3A athletic events in accordance to the UIL Constitution and Contest Rules section 1208:m.1.B; registration of video cameras will be left up to the discretion of the host school.

These procedures are simple yet provide the structure necessary to operate the 32-AAA functions with some semblance of propriety. The added responsibilities brought upon the District Chair can be minimized if these procedures are used.

FOREWORD

Each school shall be assessed a fee for the purpose of purchasing a trophy for the district winner, and to defray expenses of the district chairman. Only one trophy will be bought for the team representing the district in the playoffs. The runner-up teams representing the district shall not be awarded a trophy at the expense of District 32-AAA. The district chairman will pay all regional fees.

Play-Off Structure

- A. Best won-lost percentage district record to be declared champion.
- B. Second best won-lost percentage district record to be declared second place winner.
- C. Third best won-lost percentage district record to be declared third place winner.
- D. Any tie can be resolved by coin flip by mutual agreement.
- E. If there is a two-way tie and one team has won both mutual matches, then that team is designated “first seed” for play-off purposes. The other tying team will be designated “second seed”. Both teams shall be declared co-champions.
- F. If there is a two-way tie and each tying team has won a mutual match, then there will be a play-off between those two teams. The winner will be designated as “first seed”. Both teams will be declared co-champions. The schools concerned will arrange play-off factors. There will be a one-game play-off. (If both teams disagree to play, there will be a coin flip to decide whether they will play or not play. If the coin flip determines that the two teams will play, there will be another coin flip to determine the home site.)
- G. If there is a two-way tie for second place and each tying team has won a mutual game, there will be a single elimination play-off game to determine the second seeded team. If there is a two-way tie and one team has won both mutual matches, then that team is the district second seeded team. The other team would be the third seed representative.
- H. If there is a multiple tie among three or more schools, there will be a district play-off tournament to determine the first and second seed representative. However, if one team is undefeated in those mutual games among them, that team will represent the district as “first seed”. The same principle will apply to the remaining teams. (This will be known as the “won all mutual games” principle.) In the case of no team having won all their mutual matches, then the tournament play-off format shall be applied. Teams involved will be recognized as district champions. Mutual agreement flips. Refer to “I” for mutual agreement flip procedure.
- I. Head to Head records will determine playoff spot. If three teams tie for first (A, B, C example): Flip to determine bye with odd man drawing the bye.
 1. A draws a bye, B plays C. C defeats B. C plays A and A wins. A is the first place seed and C is the second place seed.
 2. A draws a bye and B plays C. C defeats B. C plays A and C wins. C is declared the first place seed, but A must play B to determine the second place seed.
- J. If four or more teams tie for first, a single elimination play-off tournament determined by lot (draw) will determine the first and second place teams. Teams involved will agree upon site, time and officials.
- K. In case of multiple ties for second and/or third place, the principle described in sections I, and J will apply.

32-AAA RULES FOR ALL-DISTRICT SELECTION

- A. Selection for All-District teams in 32-AAA will be in a uniform manner.
- B. The 4th place team, in each respective sport, will host all-District selections, on the 2nd Wednesday after the District certification deadline. Athletic Director/Athletic Coordinator and Head Coaches of sports will be allowed to attend a selection meeting during school hours. Selection meetings must be held after school hours, if all teams are eliminated from playoffs.
- C. Ballots will be provided in the district plan and duplicated as needed.
- D. The head coach will nominate his own players on 32-AAA approved ballots. Nominations will be hand delivered at the time of the all-district selection meeting. In specialty awards the coach will nominate one player per team, MVP, Defensive Player, etc.
- E. The host school will provide clerical help as needed. Ballots will be completed after all head coaches have arrived at the site of the meeting. Additions and scratches will be allowed at the time of meeting.
- F. Each position will be treated as a separate vote.
- G. Each coach will vote for a position. (You must vote.)
- H. Each position will be voted on and votes will be counted before continuing on to the next position. There are some inherent differences in each sport.
- A. Football and baseball select individual positions.
- B. Basketball and volleyball select entire teams as positions in some instances.
- I. Each plan will designate the individual ballots to be used, ie.: There will be 5 different ballots for basketball and volleyball: 1) Most Valuable; 2) Newcomer; 3) Offensive player of the year; 4) Defensive player of the year; 5) First Team/Second Team/Honorable Mention.
- J. Any player selected as most valuable, newcomer, or player of the year will not be included on the first team. They are above the first team and therefore automatically included on the first team.
- K. Coaches will vote for opponents' players only. As indicated on the ballot, the number of individuals to be selected for each position will be voted on as follows:
- All first team selections will be given a two (2).
 - All second team selections will be given a one (1).
- L. First team selections will be those receiving the most votes for the available positions. The second team will be those receiving the next most votes for the positions available.
- M. Any tie for any team will not be broken. Tied players will be included on the appropriate team.
- N. Honorable mention will be given to any player receiving at least one vote. Additionally, each team may place two players on the honorable mention list.
- O. Coach of the year will be the coach of the district champions.
- P. All-District teams will not be announced to the public/press until the last 32-AAA team is out of the play-offs.
- Q. Newcomer of the year is anyone who has participated in 20 % or less in a regular season schedule in the year before.
- R. All District Selection Meeting will start on time unless of extenuating circumstances arrive. Head coach or designee and no more than two assistant coaches will be allowed in All-District Selection meeting. The Head Coach or designee will be the only one who can discuss athletes at meeting.
- S. Top 3 Play-off Team's Athletic Directors or designee must attend.
- T. All Academic Team w/GPA of 90 or Better will be recognized at the All District Selection Meeting.

32-AAA DISTRICT PLAN FOR VOLLEYBALL VARSITY

1. The best over-all record through the regular district schedule will determine the district champion, runner-up, and third place teams. The district trophy will include volleyball similar to basketball and football trophies.
2. Play-off Structure (refer to page 8 of the athletic plan)
3. The home school will be responsible for freshmen officials.

On Tuesdays, if using two gyms freshmen match will begin at 5:30 p.m. and the JV match will also begin at 5:30 p.m. The Varsity match will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the JV match.

On Tuesdays, if using only gym freshmen match will begin at 5:00 p.m. The JV match will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the freshmen match and the Varsity match will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the JV match.

On Saturdays, the freshmen match will begin at 1:00 p.m. The JV match will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the freshmen match and Varsity match will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the JV match.

➤ ***Change of date and/or time of matches will be mutual agreement with schools. Prior to the match, schools need to inform all district schools of the change of dates and/or times base on school related events.***

4. U.I.L. rule applies: Rescheduling. The district executive committee may permit volleyball matches postponed by weather or public disaster (not including illness) to be played as an exception to the two-match contest per week rule, rescheduled to be played within the next seven days or next non-school day of its postponement. If the rescheduled match has to be again postponed because of the above causes, the district executive committee may permit the contest to be rescheduled again with the next non-school day from the day it was first scheduled. Every effort must be made to play each postponement at the next possible playing date. It is not necessary to wait for the seven days to elapse.
5. In case where conflicts arise due to state exams, the two schools involved may reschedule their match.
6. Eligibility will be based on the state-adopted guidelines for U.I.L. high school competition.
7. Varsity eligibility forms will be submitted prior to the first match of the season to the chairman of the district executive committee.
8. Admission for matches will be \$2.00 Adults and \$1.00 for students.
9. ALL-DISTRICT SELECTION (refer to page 9 for the Athletic Plan)

10. Positions to be selected for Volleyball are as follow:
 - A. Most Valuable Player
 - B. Newcomer of the year
 - C. Offensive Player of the year
 - D. Defensive Player of the year (should not be libero of the year)
 - E. Libero of the Year
 - F. Setter of the Year
 - G. Six- 1st Team – Ties Stay
 - H. Six – 2nd Team-Ties Stay
 - I. Honorable Mention
 - J. The coach of the year honor will be awarded to the coach whose team wins the district title.
 - K. All Academic Team w/GPA of 90 or better will be recognized at the All District Selection Meeting.

11. Varsity, JV, and freshman warm-up time will be 15 minutes, divided as follows:
 - 5 min. share net pepper
 - 4 min. visitor
 - 4 min. home
 - 2 min. serving

12. The official score keeper, libero tracker, and clock operator must be an adult for varsity games only.

13. Each school is responsible for providing a line's judge for each match.
(Varsity must be an Adult and cannot be related to a player on the team.)

14. Rally scoring format: Varsity
 - A. Matches will be played by National Federation rules outlined for the current school year.
 - B. 3 out of 5 to 25 (no Cap)
 - C. 5th Set to 15 (no Cap)

15. Home Team will provide a NFHS approved game ball.

16. Home Team will provide the visiting team with at least 15 warm up balls during the Varsity match when at the net.

FRESHMAN & JUNIOR VARIETY

1. Freshman and Junior Varsity teams will play a complete schedule with the Varsity team.
2. Ties for places stand, as there will be no play-offs at sub-varsity levels.
3. Eligibility will be based on the state-adopted guidelines for U.I.L. high school competition.
4. Each school is responsible to providing a line judge for each match.
5. Rally Scoring format: JV & Freshmen – 2 out of 3 to 25 (cap at 30). 3rd sets 15 pt. (cap 20)

JUNIOR HIGH VOLLEYBALL PLAN

1. Junior High will have both 7th and 8th grade teams. The 7th and 8th grade teams may consist of A, B, and C teams. Matches will be played on Mondays. 7th & 8th will play at the opposite site. *Prior to game day schools must notify opponent if there is no B and/or C team. If there is no C team game times will be as follows: B team-5:00 p.m. The next game will begin 15 minutes after the previous game.
2. Warm-up time will be 15 minutes for each team.
5 min. share net pepper
4 min. visitor
4 min. home
2 min. serving
3. Each school is responsible for providing a line judge for each match.
4. The official score keeper must be an adult.
5. When possible use T.A.S.O. officials.
6. Admission is \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students.
7. The Junior High teams will play one round only. Ties for places stand. At the end of the round, the team with the best record will be the District Champion. If a tie occurs, the teams involved will be declared Co-Champions.
8. Please read and comply with U.I.L. Constitution and Contest rules.
9. Junior High teams' members are limited to one match per week. Athletes may not play on the C team and then play on another team, A or B that week.
10. Junior high teams are limited to two tournaments per season.
11. Scoring will be 2 out of 3 to 25 (cap at 30)
12. Prior to the match, upon mutual agreement Seventh and Eighth grade teams will play the third game of the match even if the same team has won the first two games, provided a player in more than two games. Any student who does not play in the first two games must be allowed to participate in the entire third game.

32-AAA DISTRICT PLAN FOR CROSS COUNTRY

1. **ENTRY BLANKS** - Completed district entry forms are to be submitted to the district chair and meet host, regional entry forms to the regional director. Regional director is responsible for submitting all other forms to UIL.

Deadlines for filing entry blanks to appropriate director:

Middle School District Meet -	Progreso	(October 15, 2011)
District Meet -	5 days prior to district meet	(October 19, 2011)
High School District Meet -	Zapata	(October 22, 2011)
Regional Meet-	Brooks City Base	(November 5, 2011)
State Meet –	Old Settler’s Park	(November 11, 2011)

2. **CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE** – The top 3 teams and top 10 individuals in the varsity divisions shall qualify from district to regionals. An individual’s qualifier may also be a member of a qualifying team.
3. **DISTANCE**
- A. Varsity Girls will run 3200 meters
 - B. Varsity Boys will run 5000 meters
 - C. JV boys will run 5000 meters, JV girls, and all freshmen 3200 meters. All middle school girls will run 2400 meters and the boys 3200 meters. These distances can be altered if the head coaches agree to do so prior to the meet.
4. **ENTRY LIMITATIONS** - A minimum of five participants and a maximum of seven participants shall constitute a team. Only the first five members of the team will count for the total team score. A school may enter less than five runners; however, it cannot compete for a team title. In high school no seniors will be allowed to run on the JV level. A school may enter only one boys’ team and one girls’ team to compete for the district title. There is no limit on the number of participants in the JV, freshmen and middle schools levels; however, only the top seven runners count for scoring purposes.
5. **NUMBER OF MEETS** - Number of Meets. No student representing a participant school shall participate in more than eight meets during the school year, excluding one district meet, the regional meet and the state meet. Each meet a school team enters counts as one meet for each participating individual. Students are considered to be representing their school if they are wearing and/or using school equipment or being directed or transported by a school employee. Meets which are limited to three or fewer schools, do not count as a meet for participants, provided there is no loss of school time.
6. **TIME AND SITE** – Time and site of middle school and high school district meets shall be determined by the District Executive Committee.
7. **CERTIFICATION TO REGIONAL MEET** – Individual schools certify entries via email to the regional director. The district meet director will also certify the top three teams and top 10 individuals in the varsity divisions to the regional director.
8. **QUALIFIERS** – Each school qualifying a team may enter seven runners and three alternates to the regional meet. Each school is responsible for emailing their entries to the regional director so the names of the alternates can be included. Districts can only enter the top ten individuals and top three teams in the varsity divisions.
9. **MEET DIRECTOR** – The meet director is responsible for and has full authority for the management of the district meet.
10. **MEET REFEREE** – The athletic directors shall have final authority on all rulings based on the rules presented in the National Federation Track and Field Rules.

11. **DRESS REGULATIONS** – Contestants may not wear caps, toboggans, headbands, or jewelry. They may use string, rubber bands or tape to keep hair in place. Above items may be permitted during inclement weather. If leotard or body suit is worn shorts must be worn over them.
12. **BLOCK ASSIGNMENTS** - Block assignments are drawn by the meet director.
13. **REPORT TIME** – All runners must be ready to run at the scheduled time and should report to the start area at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the race.
14. **COURSE** – All runners shall be instructed to follow markings, which outline the course. Course maps will also be made available.
15. **STARTING** – The command will be “runners set”, when all runners have come to a still position the starter will fire the pistol. If a runner falls **DUE TO CONTACT** with another runner or an unfair start occurs, the runners will be called back by firing a second shot. In accordance to Federation rules any runner who false starts shall be disqualified.
16. **CHUTE PROCEDURES** – Chute inspectors will supervise the runners once they have entered the chute. Runners shall remain in their order until they have exited. The runners will be handed a score card according to their order of finish.
17. **UNIFORMS** – The cross country uniform consists of a minimum school issued jersey and shorts, which are not objectionable, and shoes. Each member shall wear the same color and design school uniform jersey and trucks. When other apparel is worn under the uniform by more than one team member, the apparel must be the same color ex. Under armor, t-shirts, etc... A contestant must properly wear assigned bib number if numbers are used.
18. **RULES** – Cross country rules currently found in the Federation handbook shall be enforced.
19. **DETERMINING TEAM SCORERS** – Scoring shall be as shown in the table below:

Place at finish	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	etc.
Points	1	2	3	4	5	etc.

Competitors finishing the race shall be ranked and tallied in accordance with the above table. The team score in each conference shall be determined by totaling the points scored by the first five finishers of each team. The team scoring the fewest number of points is the winner.

If fewer than five competitors from the school finish the race, the places of those competitors are disregarded in determining the team scores. Although the sixth and seventh place finishers do not score points in the team total, their place is counted in determining the scores of other teams.

Ties in team scoring shall be resolved by comparing the sixth place finishers from the tied teams. The team with the best 6th place finisher shall prevail. If one team does not have a sixth place runner, the team with a sixth place runner shall prevail. If tied teams each have only five runners, the tie will be resolved by scoring the first four finishers of each team.

20. **CROSS COUNTRY SEASON** – An official starting date has not been set by the Legislative Council.

DISTRICT MEETS

1. **MEETS** - Districts that have more than two boys' and/or two girls' cross country teams or more than five individual boys' or five individual girls' entries, conduct a district meet.
2. **DATES** – The district meet will be held on Monday the week of district certification.
3. **ENTRIES** – Each school may enter seven boys and seven girls to a district meet on the Varsity level.
4. **SPECTATORS** - Spectators must stay off the course as marked, away from the starting line and finish line, and in roped areas to avoid interfering with any aspect of the race.
5. **RESULTS** - Final results will be e- mailed and/ or faxed to each school participating in the meet. Times and places for award winners will be posted after the race has concluded and the team points totaled.

1. Varsity District Games will start at 7:30 P.M. Teams will leave the field prior to 7:15 p.m. to allow for pre-game ceremonies.
2. There will be a \$100.00 gate guarantee or 50% of the gate receipts whichever is greater.

Game expenses shall be Officials' cost plus \$350.00 of the first \$1,000.00 paid in admissions, and \$100.00 for each \$1,000.00 additional admission or fraction thereof.

A uniform game report shall be sent to the visiting team including ticket sales, gate receipts, and game expenses. Adopted district forms should be used.

3. Pre-Game ceremonies will be strictly followed.

4. The Athletic Director of the 32-AAA chairman's school shall be responsible for issuing fifteen (15) scout passes and four (4) press passes to each school. These passes are for the entire season fifty (50) administrative passes for all athletic activities will be issued to each district school. These passes will allow admission of bearer and his/her immediate family, not to exceed 4 people. THSCA and RGVCA passes will be accepted to admit the bearer to all 32-AAA football games.
5. The 28-minute time limit between halves of the football game will be strictly observed. The time allotted each school will be divided in equal halves. However, the time may be divided in another manner upon mutual agreement of both schools, but will not exceed 23 minutes total time for one band.
6. No team in district 32-AAA shall participate in a football game that is telecast live prior to district play-off games.

8. Each school will provide **80** complimentary reserved tickets for visiting school. (This shall supersede all other documents, rules, etc.)
9. Bands, pep squads, and cheerleaders in uniform and designated sponsors will be admitted to games free.
10. The home team will provide a TASO chain crew employed for a total of \$105.00 per game. If TASO chain crew is unavailable, the alternative of 3 adults may be substituted. The scoreboard clock will be the official time. In case of malfunction, the officials will keep the time on the field. All clock workers will be adults. The visiting team may have an adult present in the press box to observe timing procedures. If 25-second clocks are available, the operator will be an adult. All timers will meet with the officials prior to game time.
11. Officials will be paid according to the schedule set forth in the UIL C& CR. Proper protection for officials shall be the responsibility of the home team.
12. **TIE BREAKER SYSTEM**
- A. In the event of a two-way tie for first place, the two teams tied will be declared co-champions. The team that beats the other, in head to head competition, will represent the district as the champion.
- B. In the event of a tie for any of the 3 play-off positions by 2 teams, head to head competition will determine the order of finish.
- C. In the event of a tie for any play-off position by 3 teams, the following point system will apply:
1. A 21-point ceiling restriction will be applied to all games. No team can get more than 21 points from any one game.
 2. A team in a three-way tie that beats both of the other teams gets the highest seeding in the play-offs.
 3. Breaking multiple team ties will be accomplished by using the positive/negative points from applicable games. Example #1 - Teams A, B, and C are tied. None of the teams beat both of their opponents. The following application of the point system breaks the tie:

14. Each school is to send an eligibility form to District 32AAA Chairman.
15. The official ball shall be any officially approved football.
16. Video exchange - District 32-AAA schools will exchange the previous night's game plus two prior games of the opposing coach's choice. Videos will be exchanged Saturday at 9:00 AM at a predetermined site. Videos will be returned no later than Friday at noon. Every effort will be made to return the videos by Thursday evening. One game will consist of two videotapes:
 1. Close angle view with both sides of the line of scrimmage, linebackers and backfield
 2. Wide angle view with all 22 players
 3. Effort should be made to film down and distance between plays, to start at the break of the offensive huddle, and continue 2 seconds after the end of each play.

1. Play-off Structure - Refer to page 8 of the Athletic Plan
2. Boys and Girls high school varsity and junior varsity games will be played at opposite sites on Tuesdays and Fridays with starting times of 5:00 p.m., 6:30p.m. & 8:00 p.m. If two gyms are used, freshman and JV will play at 6 p.m. and varsity at 7:30 p.m. If the boys' teams are home, then the girls' teams are away and vice-versa. During the holidays, starting times can be moved to earlier in the day upon mutual consent of the schools involved. Boys and Girls can play together at the same site with the consent of both coaches. They must be played on both rounds.
3. Game ball – Boys' and Girl's teams will use Wilson Jet Evolution composite wide channel ball for the 2010-2011 season. The home team will provide six (6) warm-up basketballs for the visiting team.
4. U.I.L. rule applies: Rescheduling. The district executive committee may permit basketball games postponed by weather or public disaster (not including illness) to be played as an exception to the two-matched-contests per week rule, rescheduled to be played within the next seven days or next non-school day of its postponement. If the rescheduled game has to be again postponed because of the above causes, the district executive committee may permit the contest to be rescheduled again on the next non-school day from the day it was first scheduled. Every effort must be made to play each postponement at the next possible playing date. It is not necessary to wait for the seven days to elapse.
5. In cases where conflicts arise due to exams, the two schools involved may reschedule their game earlier in the week or at the latest on Saturday of the same week.
6. Any rescheduling of games for the above reasons must be conveyed to the rest of the schools in the district.
7. Eligibility will be based on the state adopted guidelines of U.I.L. high school competition.
8. Admission for games will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students.
9. Pre-Game warm-up for varsity will not exceed 15 minutes.
10. Shoot-around will be allowed with the following regulations:
 - A. From 5:15 to 5:30 p.m. and halftime of the J.V. game on your team's designated goal.
 - B. Wearing varsity game shoes.
 - C. With one of their coaches supervising.
 - D. Allow a reasonable amount of time during the JV halftime for floor to be swept.
11. At all varsity games, the score keeper and clock operator must be an adult.
12. The home team must call in district scores immediately following their home district games to the Valley Morning Star and/or the McAllen Monitor.
13. The home team must section off two rows behind the visiting team for the visiting sub-varsity teams to sit.

SUB-VARSITY

1. Junior varsity and freshman teams will play a complete schedule with the varsity team on Tuesdays and Fridays.
2. Ties for places stand, as there will be no play-offs at sub-varsity levels.
3. Junior varsity and freshmen games will be eight-minute quarters and will run on regulation time.
4. Eligibility will be based on the state adopted guidelines for U.I.L. high school competition.
5. Freshmen teams will play three rounds with the last two rounds counting as district games. First round opponents are optional.

JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

1. The junior high A and B teams will play one round only. Ties for places stand. If the boys' teams are home, the girls' teams are away, and vice-versa. Jr. High boys will play on Thursdays except for the last game, which will be played on Monday. Jr. High girls will play on Mondays. The 7th grade will play together and the 8th grade will play at opposite site. The B-team plays at 5:00pm followed by the A – team at 6:00pm. Basketball Junior High Boys and Girls plan – If two schools are able to field three teams (“A”, “B” and “C”) against each other they may follow this format: “C” team will start at 5:00pm. This game will be 6:00 minute running quarters. The clock will stop for shooting fouls. There will be a ten-minute half time. “B” and “A” teams will start immediately after each other. They will be given a ten minute half. These games will be run at eight minute regulation quarters.
2. At the end of the round the team with the best record will be District Champion. If a tie occurs, the teams involved will be declared Co-Champions.
3. Eight-minute quarters will be used for all junior high games. Since junior high plays only one game a week, the clock will be run on regulation time.
4. In case of a tie at the end of regulation, an overtime period of 3 minutes will be played. If there is still a tie after the overtime period, a sudden death play will determine the winner. A jump ball will start the game, the overtime period, and the sudden death play.
5. Junior high boys and girls will use a regulation basketball.
6. Eligibility will be based on the state adopted guidelines for U.I.L. junior high competition.
7. Game officials should be members of the basketball officials association and attend rules meetings. (When possible use TASO Officials)
8. Admission for junior high games will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students.
9. Official score keeper must be an adult (home team).

1. **Play-off Structure** – Refer to page 8 of the Athletic Plan
(Head to Head Records For Play – Off Purpose)

2. **Game times** will be as followed:
 - A. Tuesday DOUBLEHEADER game-JV-5:00 Varsity -7:30 pm. If mutually agree upon 4:30
 - B. Friday DOUBLEHEADER game –JV-5:00 Varsity – 7:30 p.m.
 - C. Teams may play JV Games on Monday/Saturday if mutually agreed by the two schools.
 - D. If no JV game scheduled, the Varsity game will begin at 6:00 p.m.
 - E. Saturday games – TBA

3. **In and Out Workout** Format:
 - A. Home team will start in and out workout first; 35 minutes before game time duration of in and out will not exceed 15 minutes.
 - B. Visiting team will start in and out workout 20 minutes before game time, immediately after the home team - duration not to exceed 15 minutes.
 - C. With 5 minutes remaining until game time, both teams will clear the field and coaches will meet with game officials prior to home team taking the field.

4. **Rain Out Games** (*No Game Played or Started*)-National Federation Rules apply.
 - A. If field conditions are unplayable due to weather, a decision made by the athletic directors of participating schools will be made by 12:00 noon on game day to determine game site.
 - B. In the first round, if the home field is unplayable, the site will be reversed. If neither site is playable, the game must be played on the next available date at the home team's site. If the site remains unplayable, the game must be played at the opponent's field if it is playable. In any case the site will be reversed in the second round.
 - C. If the rain out occurs in the second round, the game may be played on the next available date at the home team site designated by the home team. The game may be played at a neutral site designated by the home team.

** NOTE: It is the responsibility of the home team to make all arrangements with media, officials, administrators, etc. Time or rescheduled game must adhere to the 32-AAA District Plan for Baseball (section 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d & 2e). If the game time must be changed due to unforeseen circumstances all 32-AAA athletic directors must be notified.

5. Suspended Games

- A. If officials suspend a game before completing 5 innings (4½ if the home is ahead) the game must be played on the next available date at the home site. The game will continue from the time of suspension, with every effort to obtain the same officials. If the same officials are not available, the assigning secretary will assign new officials. The suspended game will be continued the same line-up and National Federation of State High School Associations rules will apply for completion of the game.
- B. Games suspended after completing 5 innings (4½ innings if the home team is ahead) shall constitute a completed game. Any game suspended during the 6th inning or beyond will revert back to the score at the end of the last completed inning. *Exception: Power Outage - refer to 5A.*

6. A forfeit will be declared 30 minutes after the scheduled starting time (not enough players or other circumstances), unless coaches have made contact to explain the extenuating circumstances. The final score will be 7 – 0.

7. Officials / Officials “no show”

- A. Varsity games require a two-man crew from R.G.C. SBOA (or Kingsville/Alice). If only one umpire shows, the game will be played only by mutual agreement of the two coaches. If the coaches do not agree, they must adhere to 32-AAA Baseball Plan rule 5-A .For sub-varsity games, local SBOA, or a coach from the home school can umpire. JV games must be played if at all possible.
- B. If there are no officials for a game, the game needs to be played on next available date. Coaches will determine the next available playable date and adhere to the UIL rule.

8. Ties: (Varsity) Ties will be played out on an agreeable date/next playable date in accordance to National Federation rules. JV ties will remain.

9. Official game ball will be the Diamond D-1 NFHS approved for Varsity Games.

10. Time Limit- J.V. games will have a two hour time limit. No inning will start after one hour and fifty minutes. Varsity 10 run rule in effect after 5 innings. Varsity 15 run rule in effect after 3 innings.

11. Websites: Each team will designate an individual to update statistics on MAXPREPS on a weekly basis. Scores/Team Information can also be updated on 3abaseball.com (email at administrator@3abaseball.com).

12. Admission for contests will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for students.

13. No baseball games, Varsity or JV, will coincide with District Track Meet dates or Regional Track Meet dates.

14. All other rules as listed in the Constitution and Contest Rules of the U.I.L. will be followed.

15. All-District selections – Refer to page 9 of the District Athletic Plan.
Use a 4 – slot nomination ballot.

1. A trophy will be presented to the district champion as per executive committee policy.
2. At the District Track Meet, 4 men's coach and 4 ladies coach from each school will be allowed in the infield area during finals. Plus Athletic Director/ Athletic Coordinator.
3. The district track meet will begin no earlier than 9:00 a.m. on the designated day.
4. For organizational purposes only, 5 days prior to each district track meet, the athletic directors will have organizational meetings to discuss items concerning the district track meets. At these meetings, appropriate official entries (junior high, JV, and varsity) will be turned in on official U.I.L. entry forms (with full names) to the meet director. At this meeting, the time of the scratch/add meeting (to be held on the day of each meet) will be determined. This item does not supersede the UIL C&CR and is not a District Executive Committee policy. Under no circumstances will issue related to item result in disqualification of any student athlete.
 - A. No seniors will be allowed to compete in JV meets.
5. The district track meet will be videotaped ~ all running events.
 - A. A camera will be used at the finish line.
 - B. The meet referee alone will view the tape and his decision will stand on any protests that may arise.
 - C. In case of a protest no medals will be presented until the meet referee makes the final decisions.
 - D. Schools involved in protest must be notified immediately after the protest is filed.
6. It is up to the individual coach to check with meet director on regional qualifiers at the end of the varsity district track meet. There will be a head track coaches' meeting with the meet director at the completion of the district meets.
7. B teams are allowed for JV teams in individual events not relays, no points and they can't advance to finals.
8. No baseball games will be scheduled on the dates of the district track meet.
9. Junior high boys and girls district track meet:
 - A. Preliminary and final heats will follow the high school district meet format for running and field events.
 - B. Field and running events will rotate yearly between boys and girls.
 - C. 300M hurdles for boys and 300M hurdles for girls will be included in the district meet.
 - D. "A" teams will be awarded points for total team standings.
 - E. Junior high boys and girls will use the 4-kilo shot put.
 - F. B teams allowed, but no awards or points for total team standings, and they can't advance to finals.

10. Relays:
 - A. All participants will be listed at the scratch meeting the day of the district track meet.
 - B. Relay cards are mandatory in all relays – 400 M. Relay, 800 M. Relay, and 1600 M. Relay. The card must include full names and the name of the school.
11. Any student athlete participating in the district track meet must wear school colors and be using school issued equipment.
12. The **district track** meet directors are responsible for securing all the following officials. These individuals will be paid for working the district track meets:
 - Referee (\$150)
 - Finish Judge (\$150)
 - Starter (\$200)
 - Marshall (\$150)
 - 2 Video persons w/ two cameras (\$75 each) or Accutrac, Lynx
 - Back-up Starter (\$200)
 - Announcer (\$150)
13. Junior high track meet will include U.I.L. recommended events.
14. Admission for the JH and HS District Track meets will be \$2.00 adults and \$1.00 for students.
15. The pole vault event will follow Track Federation Rules:
 - A. The athlete must not weigh more than the weight specified on the pole.
 - B. A roped off area must be provided to keep out spectators and coaches.
 - C. Pole vault will be added to the girl's events.
 - D. UIL added the 4 x 200m relay to the boy's events.
16. District Executive will pay for 1 dozen caps per School.

ATTENTION COACHES, ATHLETIC DIRECTORS, ADMINISTRATORS:

Any student who participates in a U.I.L. athletic activity must be an amateur and in compliance with Section 441 of the U.I.L. Constitution. This means a tennis player cannot receive free equipment, reduced-price equipment or equipment on loan. The equipment includes (but is not limited to) rackets, balls, shoes, socks, articles of clothing, duffel bags, strings, etc. The coach is responsible for playing only participants who are eligible by U.I.L. rules.

DISTRICT MEET ON MARCH 31 & APRIL 12, 2011 (LA FERIA HIGH SCHOOL)

1. Divisions, Entries, Restrictions, Draw Meeting.
 - A. Boys and girls divisions for the district meet:
 - high school boys, singles and doubles
 - high school girls, singles and doubles
 - high school boys' and girls' mixed doubles
 - B. Entries:
 - Varsity: At the district tournament, each school may enter two boys' singles and two girls' singles and two boys' doubles and two girls' doubles teams.
 - Each school will be limited to 2 entries in the main draw. Only these 2 entries will count toward team points.

However, a school with extra entries will be allowed to enter 2 extra entries provided that those 2 extra entries play their own teammates to decide which teams move into their school's allotted 2 slots in the main draw.

In case of excessive entries, a separate draw and tournament will be held for these players. This draw will be in addition to the regular main draw.

- C. Deadline:
 - No entries shall be allowed for district tournaments, which are not mailed to or received by the director on or before the tenth day before the first day of the meet. An eligibility list, certified by the principal, must be sent to the district chair prior to the first scheduled contest.
 - Round-robin format will be used a draw is reduced to 3 entries.
- D. Restrictions:
 - a. No girl's team may compete against boy's teams and vice-versa.
 - b. No boys or girls will be allowed to compete in both singles and doubles
- E. Draw meeting:

A meeting will be held the week prior to the district tournament to create the official draw.
2. Number of matches and sets.
 - A. Sets:
 - a. In all boys' and girls' matches at district, regional, and state tournaments, the best two out of three sets shall determine the winners.
 - b. The 12-point tie break scoring system will operate when the score reaches six games all in any set.

- B. Matches:
- a. A contestant shall not play more than three matches per day.
 - b. A minimum of one hour's rest for a team or player shall be allowed between the close of one match and the beginning of another.
2. Substitutions – Scratch and add meeting:
- A. A scratch and add meeting will be held the morning of the tournament to allow coaches to make changes in their entries.
 - B. All other substitutions shall follow the established guidelines of the U.I.L. as listed in Section 902 of the U.I.L. Constitution.
3. Other Guidelines
- A. Uniforms
 - a. Individuals and teams representing their school shall wear school-approved clothing.
 - b. The clothing shall be in school colors, similar in design, and have the school identifying logo or name clearly visible.
 - c. Hats or visors must be school issued worn with the bill forward and in an appropriate manner as determined by the meet director.
 - B. Coaching:
 - a. A coach may coach players only during the 90-second change over at the end of adds games and during the 10-minute rest period for split sets.
 - b. Only the school tennis coaches may coach the players.
 - c. The coach must coach in a manner, which does not interfere with play on adjoining courts.
 - d. Coaches are not allowed on the court: They must remain behind the fence or windscreen.
 - C. Point penalty system:
 - a. All players are warned prior to the start of the tournament.
 - b. 1st. offense – 1 point
2nd offense – 2 points
3rd offense – 4 points
4th offense – default
 - c. All penalty points are cumulative throughout the tournament.
 - D. Seeding:
 - a. At the district tournament, two entries will be seeded in accordance with current year results, which will be presented to the director at the draw meeting.
 - b. Players will not be seeded if accurate details are not presented.
 - E. Judging:
 - a. 32-3A will pay the meet referee \$100.
 - b. The meet director is responsible to secure the meet referee.
 - F. Tournament Fees: Court fees will be paid by District, as needed.
 - G. Awards:
 - a. Medals-Top 3 for the Varsity, JV, freshman and Jr. High meet.
 - b. 2- 28" Trophies awarded to District Champion.

**32-AAA DISTRICT PLAN FOR GOLF
DISTRICT GOLF- APRIL 11, 2011- PSJA-SOUTHWEST (TIERRA DEL SOL)**

1. GENERAL RESPONSIBILITY
It shall be the responsibility of the host school (Principal or Game Supervisor) to initiate corrective measures at all district golf meets to prevent unusual disturbances from individuals or groups and to prevent the use of noise making instruments.
2. METHOD OF DETERMINING DISTRICT CHAMPION
A .One-day meet will have an eighteen (18)-whole shotgun format.
B.The meet director shall determine the district golf meet schedule.
3. MEET DIRECTOR
A. 32-3A Athletic Directors will serve as the Meet Referees.
B. The meet director shall be responsible for organizing the district meet.
C. Site and date to be set the spring prior.
D. The Meet Director shall organize the meet in accordance with U.I.L. Constitution and Contest Rules and District 32-AAA rules.
E. The District Tournament will be held no more than two weeks before the District Golf Certification date.
4. PROTEST – Protests shall be made to the meet director/ committee, who may seek the advice of the resident pro, prior to starting the next hole and his decision, shall be final. This final decision does not prohibit the filing of a complaint. See general policy Section 1, page 2, Rule 1.
5. AWARDS – Varsity (Boys & Girls)
2 – 28” Team Trophies
2 each – Individual Medals (Gold, Bronze, Silver) for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.UNIFORMS
6. UNIFORMS
A. Individuals and teams representing their school shall wear school-approved clothing.
B. The clothing shall be in school colors and similar in design.
C. Caps and/or visors, if worn, are considered part of the uniform and must be school issued and school colors.
7. Each school in the district will provide the necessary monitors required to accommodate each group that participates in the district tournament.
8. Pairings for the first day of the tournament will be determined by the athlete’s average handicap. The pairings for the second day will be established by team scores of the first day.
9. The Monitor is by definition an observer and scorekeeper. The Monitor is NOT there to make rulings or advise the players. The Monitor is there to keep score and observe questions of fact; e.g. *IS THE BALL LOST IN A HAZARD OR OUTSIDE A HAZARD?* The Monitor should be knowledgeable of the sport of Golf and need not be a school employee. Monitor is the Official Scorekeeper.
10. The district will hold a meeting on the Wednesday prior to the district golf meets. The meeting will be used to establish pairings for the district golf tournament and discuss items concerning the tournament.
11. Entries should be provided to the meet director 10 days prior to the tournament.
12. The 10 low scores in the district tourney will be designated as the all district team, including the MVP.
13. Monitors for the district tournament will be placed with their pairings by Draw.
14. Each school must declare their tournament date by the second week of January.

4. Junior varsity games will have a run limit of 5 or three outs per inning. This game will also have a time limit of an hour and a half with no inning beginning after an hour and twenty minutes. JV ties will remain.
5. Rain Out Games/Suspended Games – National Federation Rules apply. If field conditions are unplayable due to weather, a decision made by the athletic directors of participating schools will be made by 12:00 noon on game day to determine game site.
 - a. If the field conditions are unplayable due to weather, a decision made by the athletic directors of participating schools will be made by 12:00 noon on game day to determine game site.
 - b. In the first round, rain out games will be played at the opponent's available field that day if the home field is not available. Also, if neither site is available, the game may be played at a mutual site or next available date. Site will be reversed second round.
 - c. If the rain out occurs in the second round, the game may be played at a neutral site if not available date at the home team's site.*NOTE: It is the responsibility of the home team to make all arrangements with the media, officials, and administrator's, etc. time or reschedule game must adhere to the 32-AAA District Plan for Softball (section 3a, 3b, & 3c). If game time must be changed due to unforeseen circumstances, all 32-AAA athletic directors must be notified.
 - d. If there are no officials for a game, the game needs to be played on next available date. Coaches will determine the next available playable date and adhere to UIL rule.
 - e. If officials suspend a game the game must be played on next available date at the home site. The game will continue from the time of suspension, with every effort to obtain the same officials. If they are not available, new officials will be assigned by the assigning secretary. The suspend game will be continued with same line-up and positions. Games suspended after completing 5 innings (4 1/2 innings if the home team is ahead) shall constitute a completed game. Any game suspended during the 6th inning or beyond will revert back to the score at the end of the last completed inning. (Exception power outage)
6. A forfeit will be declared 30 minutes after the scheduled starting time (not enough players or other circumstances), unless coaches have made contact to explain the extenuating circumstances. The final score will be 7 – 0.

7. Officials – Two (2) certified officials of local TASO chapters will call each game. If only one official show up, the game may be played by mutual agreement of the coaches.
8. Each school is to send a varsity eligibility form to the district chairman prior to the first contest.
9. Game balls will meet national Federation and UIL rules (Dudley optic yellow, 12 inch, .47 cores).
10. All-District Selections – Refer to page 9 of the District Plan.
