What is Photoshop?

- An image-editing program that allows you to manipulate graphic images.
 - Some techniques used to manipulate/modify images include:
 - Rotating
 - Resizing
 - Changing colors
 - Adding text

What can you do?

- Take a color picture and convert it to black and white
- Modify the colors of the picture
- Remove blemishes on the picture
- Enlarge/reduce a picture size
- Create logos

File Formats

- Some formats that Photoshop supports:
 - Photoshop .PSD
 - Bitmap .BMP
 - Graphics .GIF
 - Tagged Image Format .TIF or .TIFF
 - JPEG Picture Format .JPG, .JPE, .JPEG
 - Photoshop PDF .PDF
 - Kodak PhotoCD .PCD
